UNION COUNTY, South Carolina is soliciting sealed and competitive bid proposals for the APRON & TAXILANES REHABILITATION PROJECT at the Union County Airport, FAA A.I.P. Project No. 3-45-0056-015-2022, BID# AP-22-03-101, until 2:00p.m. local prevailing time on Thursday, March 31, 2022. Bid proposals will be accepted at the Union County Airport Terminal at 198 Airport Road, Union, SC 29379. Any bid received after the scheduled closing time for receipt of bids shall be returned to the bidder unopened.

SCOPE OF WORK

The construction work shall generally consist of the rehabilitation of approximately 6,245 square yards of aircraft parking apron and 8,927 square yards of taxilane pavements. The work will include related work items consisting of pavement demolition, construction of aggregate base course, earthwork, pavement marking, aircraft tie-down installation, shoulder grading and grassing, and limited erosion control measures.

PRE-BID MEETING

A *NON-MANDATORY* Pre-Bid Meeting will be held at **11:00 a.m.** on Wednesday, March **16**, **2022** at Union County Airport Terminal Building. The purpose of this meeting is to highlight the Project, explain pertinent FAA regulations and requirements and provide bidders a chance to visit the site.

A Notice-of-Award for the Contract will be issued once a successful bidder has been determined and adequate funding has been secured by the Owner.
