

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday, Sep 26, 2024 at 12:00 noon, in the second floor board room of the Catawba Regional Council of Governments at 215 Hampton Street, Suite 200, Rock Hill, SC 29730, the counties of Chester, Lancaster, Union, and York will hold a joint public hearing to review the performance and accomplishments conducted under the Community Development Block Grant – Coronavirus 1 (“CDBG-CV1”) Project Grant (#CDBG-CV1 003). This project consisted of serving home-delivered meals to senior citizens in Chester, Lancaster, Union, and York Counties as well as related costs for equipment, supplies, staffing, and administration.

Lancaster County, acting as the lead county for the Catawba Region, received a \$913,381.47 CDBG-CV1 grant to carry out these activities, which represents 100 percent of the total project budget. The project expended \$553,596.12 for home-delivered meals, \$276,751.35 for equipment and supplies, and \$83,034.00 for administration.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of Union County’s Citizens Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program, providing for the participation of the citizens of Union County in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds. The Citizens Participation Plan is available for review in the office of the Union County Supervisor, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.
